ITI Theme Night: Aesthetic integration: Restorative procedures and key for success

Currently, the combination of technical knowledge and aesthetic concepts is a strategy to enable restorative procedures to be integrated into the patient care, from both an aesthetic and functional perspective.

The high expectations of patients must make us reflect on the technique and materials we use in each particular case. Focusing on the anterior region and analysing simultaneously white aesthetic (restoration) and pink aesthetic (soft tissue).

We will analyse from the restorative perspective the fundamental aspects needed to reach an aesthetic integration:

- Emergency profiles and gingival architecture (bone level and tissue level)
- Anatomy: Shape, colour value and translucency
- Abutments selection (Zi, Cares, etc..)
- Screwed, cemented, custom abutments (Au, zi)
- Restorative materials (Metal-ceramic, zirconium, Press ceramic)
- Cad-cam technology (CARES)

Directions, applications and how this technology can help us to improve our final restoration in daily practice.

The interaction of these factors mean that each case needs to be treated individually in order to obtain a predictable protocol to all cases and achieve our goal: Aesthetic integration.

Objectives:

- How new materials and technology can improve our restorative procedures
- Integration between Pink and White aesthetics
- Handling and design of the emergence profile from the prosthetic point
